Course content	<p>Level 1 (A1)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listening skills: Short dialogues will enable you to recognize familiar words and basic sentences. At the end of the course, you will understand Italian when spoken slowly and clearly. • Speaking skills: We will practice the pronunciation of Italian intensely. At the end of the course, you can form short and simple sentences. You can also ask questions and answer them, but only when they deal with very familiar topics. • Reading skills: You will learn to read short and simple texts. • Writing skills: At the end of the course, you will be able to write short messages and fill out forms with personal information.
